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2. Which parts of the photograph are the most significant?

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Why?

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3. Is the subject posed or captured spontaneously?

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Why is this important?

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4. What do you think were the photographer's intentions?

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Did the photographer have an agenda in taking this photograph?

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5. What point of view or perspective is not included in this photograph?

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6. In broad terms, what does the photograph tell you about the time period in which it was taken?

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7. Write a title and a caption for this photograph.

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8. Put yourself inside the picture. Imagine taking a walk around the scene.
- What do you see, hear, and smell?

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What types of things can you touch or taste?

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- What are you wearing?

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What does your clothing feel like? Is it comfortable?

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- Have you been to a place like this before? How was it similar or different?

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
